

## Art and Craft Activity

Week 11: Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2020

This week we are going to think about the ladybirds that we often find in our gardens.

Use your cutting and sticking skills to create a ladybird collage.

For the collage you will need:

Scissors, glue, coloured paper, black pen.

Or - use lines and shapes to draw a picture of ladybirds in the grass.



1. Use brown paper - cut wavy lines. Stick this on for the ground.
2. Use green paper - cut lots of thin strips of paper. Arrange these and stick them on for the grass.
3. Use red paper - cut circles. Arrange these and stick them on for the ladybirds.
4. Use a black pen. Draw a head on each ladybird-make them all face different directions!
5. Use black pen. Draw the wings- draw a centre line and spots on each ladybird. Remember to draw the same number of spots on each side!
6. Use black pen. Draw antennae and legs on your ladybirds.
