Task 1: Think about what instructions are for and how they are set out on when you write them. Below is a checklist to remind you of all the things you could include to make your instructions amazing. Remember a new line for each new instruction.

Instructions Checklist

Use "How to..." in the title	
Lists (e.g. materials/ingredients/equipment)	
Numbers/letters or bullet points to show order	
Imperative verbs (e.g. mix/stir)	
Short, clear sentences	
Diagrams/illustrations	

Task 2: Write your own instructions using your checklist.

Challenge yourself to use:

- Adverbs of time (for example... first, next, finally, after that)
- Adverbs of manner (for example... quickly, carefully, slowly)
- A range of adjectives
