Tuesday 23.6.20	Art	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Painted rocks are all the rage these days. It would be lovely if we did a river of painted rocks, as part of a collaborative art project. 1. Talk for writing – retell a story (traditional fairy-tale). Write a plan using picture and learn it by memory or a story board
2. Use the below writing prompt to write about a place where there are no grown-ups allowed! It can be an imaginary or a

**No Grown-ups... Writing Prompt**

How to Write Your Letter

While you can write to your future self from any time period, I recommend to start with either 5 or 10 year's time frame.

Refer to today's date.

Imagine writing to your future self exactly 5 or 10 years from now.

What do you want to say to him/her?

Some consideration points:

What do you want to be one year from now?

What are the goals and dreams you want realised by then?

Career/Business/Studies? Money/Wealth? Family? Friends? Health?

Recreation? Contribution? Self-Image?

Once you're done, sign off with your name and today's date.

Keep your letter in a safe place.

Put the papers in an envelope. Seal it.

On the cover, write "To [Your Name]. To be opened on [Date]."

Put this envelope in a safe place where no one can access it. 😊
