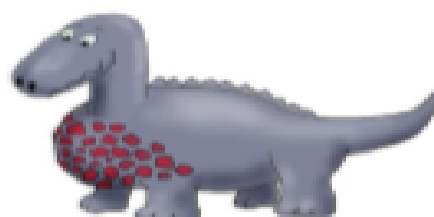


FAVOURITE DINOSAUR
