Answer the following questions on a piece of paper.

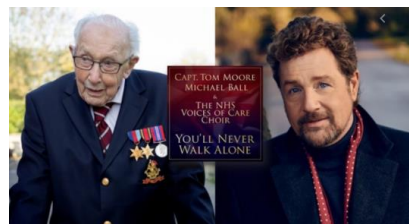
Remember a capital letter and a full stop. You can either use the sheet provided if you have access to a printer or just use a plain piece of paper and a pencil.
