Today you will look at some of the most significant parts of the Christian religion. We will look at the people, places and things connected with Christianity.



Christians follow the teachings of Jesus Christ - also known as the Holy Trinity.

There are 2.5 billion Christians worldwide.


Christianity came from Judaism, Jesus was a Jew.


