

## SQUARES Maths Week 6 – Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> February

Today you are going to look at the concept of division as sharing.

When you divide a quantity, remember to always use the largest number first – the **WHOLE**. You will then need to look carefully at the number you are asked to share it into - **PARTS**.

You have cooked 8 pizzas and you want to share them with your friend.

Your whole will be 8 and you need to share into 2 groups –  $8 \div 2 = 4$



If you share them between 2 people each person would have 4 pizzas each.



If you were shown  $8 \div 4 = 2$



**Task:** Look at the objects and show the answer to the equation. Count the whole first. You can use pictures to help you if you need to.

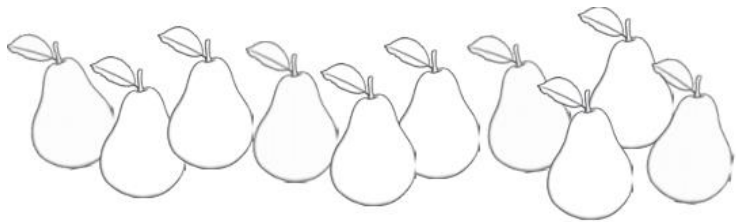

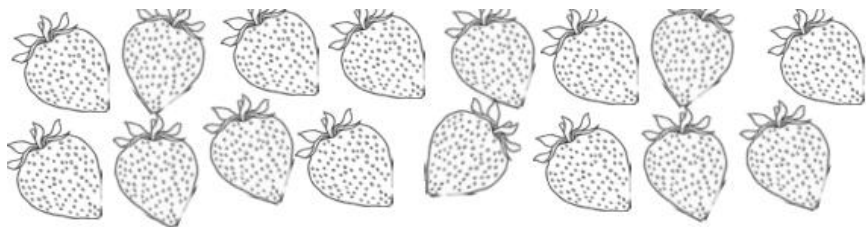
