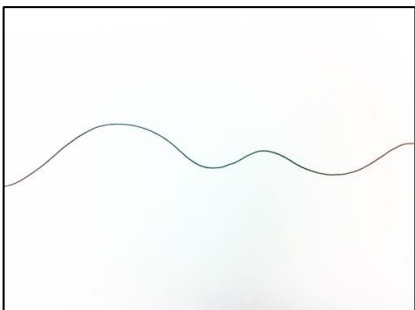


## Art – WB 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021

Over the past few weeks you have been having a go at creating your own optical art. This week you are going to have a go at some more optical art, this time using bumps.

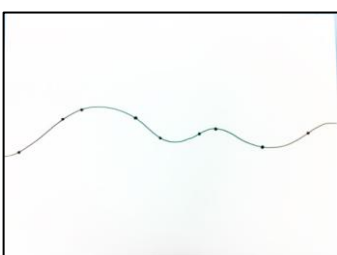
Task: Follow the instructions below to create your own art work in the style of Bridget Riley. You will need a piece of paper, a pencil and some crayons. Please take a photo of your work and send it to us via class do jo.

### Step 1



Start by drawing a curved line across the paper. Think rolling hill... not roller coaster!

### Step 2



Add 8 dots across the line. They should be different lengths apart. You need a dot close to the edges of your paper.

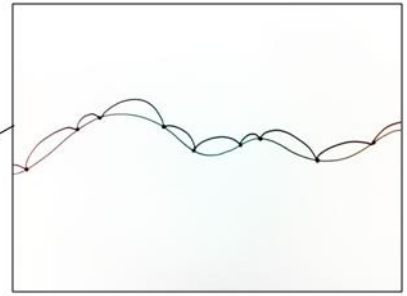
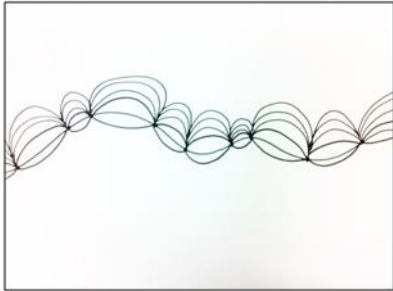
### Step 3

Start connecting the dots with bumps.

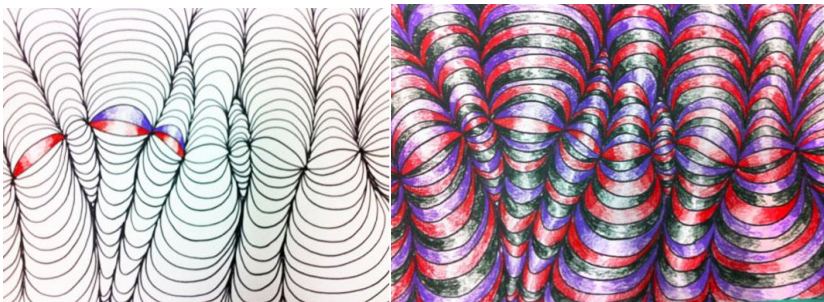
The lines from the dots close to the edge will go off the edge of the paper to an imaginary dot.

The lines will eventually go off the top and bottom of the paper.

Fill the whole paper.



### Step 4



Pick a group of colours you feel work well together (2 or 3).

Using pencil crayons, fill in the spaces. Press harder in the corners. As you get near the top of each bump, press lighter and lighter.

Continue until the work is complete.
