1. Look at the picture below:

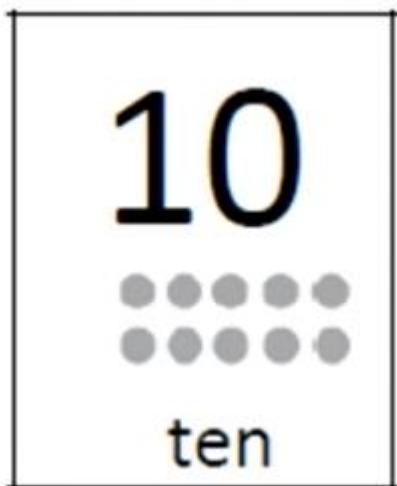
- How many trees are there?

- How many glasses of orange juice are there?
- Can you use your counting objects to represent the number you have just counted?



2. What numbers is show in the card below? Can you represent the number using your counting objects?



3. We want to find one more than 13. Remember to find one more you add one to the number/objects you have just counted. What is one more than 13?
4. Can you represent the number on the card below and find one more than the number?



Main task:

Can you choose a number card, represent the number and then find one more than the number you have chosen. Remember to say the sentence 10 is one more than 9 or one greater than 11 is 12.
